

**December, 2005 - NetStar-1 Re-Aligns Major Program Team, Promotes William Dellamar to Vice President.**

NetStar-1, Inc. (Rockville, MD) has announced the promotion of William Dellamar to the position of Vice President, responsible for the management of a wide range of services provided to the US Department of Labor under a recently-awarded contract.
